# ACCESSIBLE TRANSPORTATION VOUCHER PROGRAM

## WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE

The voucher program makes wheelchair accessible transportation available evenings, weekends, and holidays when other accessible transportation is typically not available.

### All trips must begin and end inside of Delaware County.

Outside of the MITSPPlus service area, it is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Inside the MITSPPlus service area, it is available whenever MITSPPlus is not operating.

There is no restriction on trip purpose.

The service is limited to people who are certified as disabled through MITSPPlus.

Rides can be requested immediately, like a taxi service, or reserved in advance.

## VOUCHERS

Service is available with a voucher only.

### Vouchers cost \$7 each.

Customers who have old vouchers may continue to use them.

Vouchers are not transferable and will not be refunded for any reason.

## PERSONAL CARE ATTENDANT

Customers who are certified as needing a Personal Care Attendant (PCA) when they travel should ask that their vouchers be stamped PCA. This allows the PCA to ride along at no charge.

The origin and destination of the PCA must be exactly the same as the customer. Space for the PCA must be reserved when scheduling a ride.
